Hello Dixie BCA Members,

I think Spring is here! It's been a long, wet, and cold winter up here in the mountains. I saw a robin and I think a couple of the doe deer are about to spring.

So, it is time to get our beautiful Buicks running and start touring. I'm sure everyone properly winterized your babies and it's time to wake them up. First check the fluid levels and look underneath to see if there are any puddles. Check tire pressures and especially the spare! (We recently had to put the space saver tire on Allison's car and it only had 17 PSI.)

When the battery is charged, it is time to liberally pump the gas pedal and crank the engine. The carburetor will probably be empty so it will take several seconds before gas will be pumped into the carburetor. Good luck!

Last year we drove the Riv to Charlotte and again to Hilton Head with no gas gauge. Getting 15 MPG with no gas gauge was a little unsettling. So for my winter project, I determined the gauge was good and the sending unit in the tank was bad. I bought a sending unit from O'Reilly and another from CARS, in case one was bad. I had my mechanic, Mr. Fixit, drop the tank and replace the sending unit. Sure enough, the O'Reilly unit was bad. It only took 2 hours for them to drop the gas tank, replace the CARS sending unit and re-install the tank. \$169. Wow! I now have a gas gauge.

Get ready for the Buick Bowl A Roma. March 8th. If the weather is good, I'm bringing a Buick.

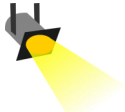

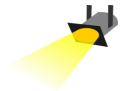

LUNCH TIME: After Bowling, at about 2:30 p.m. with awards & monthly business meeting to follow.

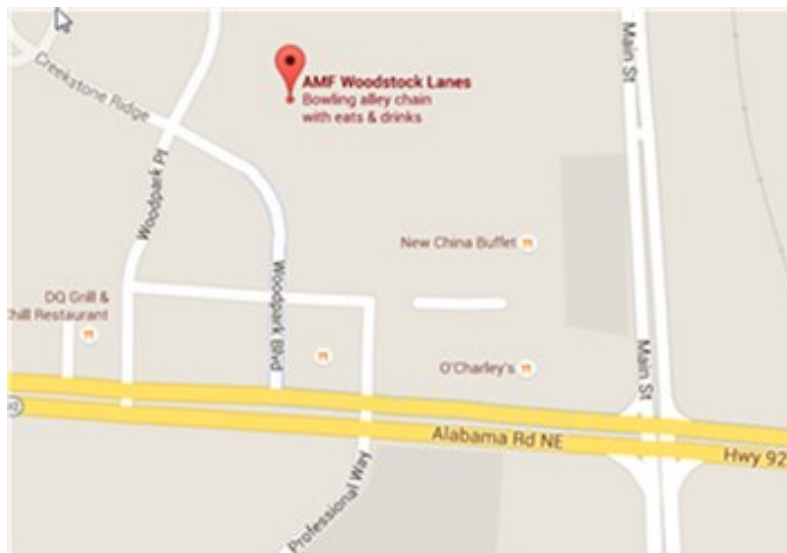
The cost is \$20.00 and includes 3 games of bowling, shoe rental & lunch, or \$10.00 for those having lunch only.

The featured marques this year are Rolls Royce and Bentley, although all makes are welcome. Perhaps even your Buick?

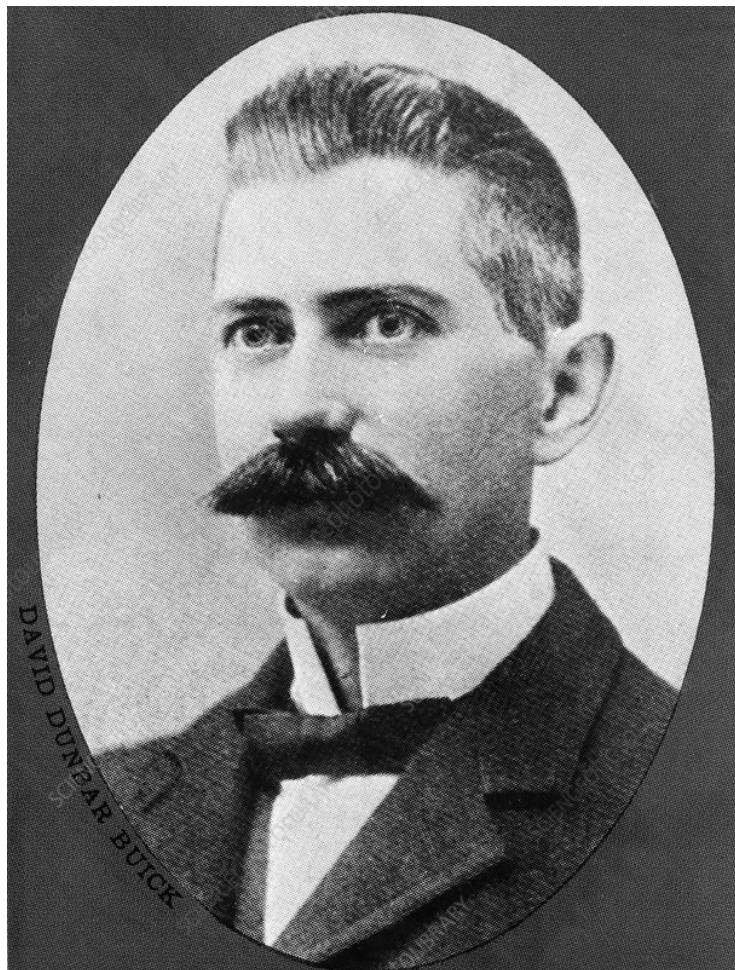
On Sunday, the 3rd, there will be a Car and Caffeine event at the resort, and all cars are welcome to display along side the winners of the previous day's concourse.

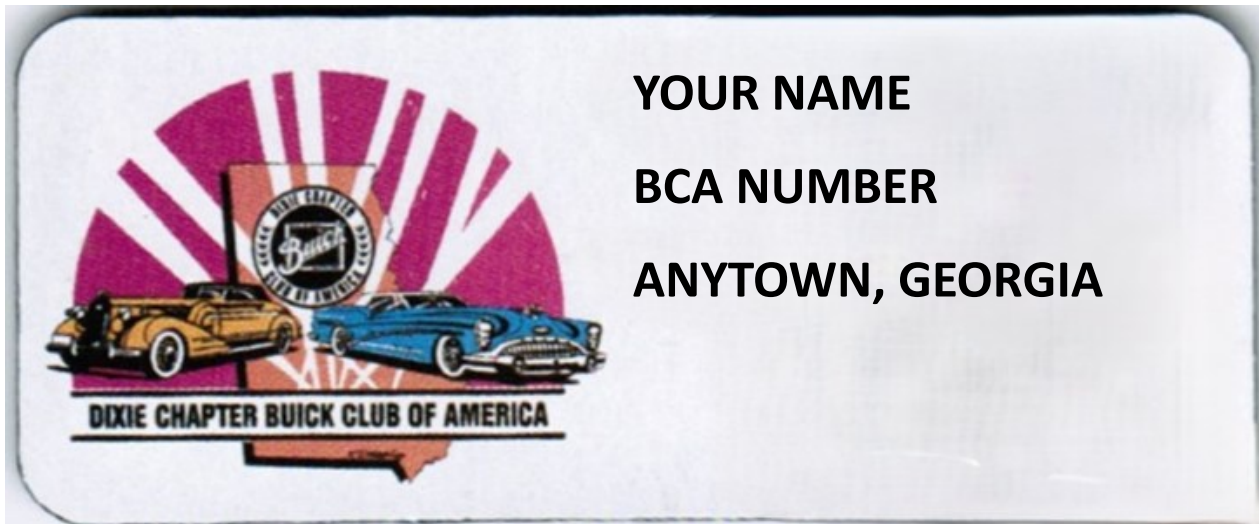

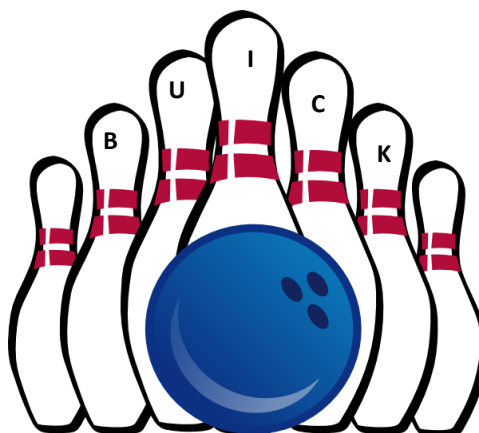

If you plan to arrive a day early for the tour, the hotel has given us a reduced rate for Saturday night, although it's not the block rate. They have discounted that rate to \$134 + tax. Be sure to mention the BDE or Buicks. Once you register for the tour, we will send you confirmation and they will provide us a link so you can re-serve online. Please do not cancel your hotel reservation should your plans change. Contact us first, we will take care of changing the name on the reservation, in case we have a waiting list that will need this room. If you come in early and wish to take in a side trip on your own, Walton's Mountain Museum is about 36 miles (50 min) drive to the south. April they are only open on weekends.

Take a look at what you'll do in the Valley in April:

Sunday 4/26: We will gather and settle in at the Best Western Waynesboro and re-new old friendships and greet new members early afternoon in the pre-event hall, by the conference rooms. Registration will be open Sunday afternoon about 2pm. Plan to pick up your book and packet upon arrival. We will serve a light hot appetizer at 6:00 followed by a brief welcome and sharing of some information on the week's events, especially Monday morning as we need to run like a well-oiled machine (Buick). Please plan to attend, grab a bite to eat and hang around to hear what's happening. This will save some time in the AM.

Be sure to keep your gas tanks full as we have some long days of travel!

Monday 4/27: Bright and early we will meet and take care of morning business in 15 mins! Can we achieve this goal? Yes we can. Thanks to the update from Sunday evening's informal gathering. RT is 90 miles. First stop, Jefferson's Monticello. We'll be in 3 groups to tour the house. We have strict time guidelines laid out by the estate that we must adhere to. So apologies ahead of time that we need to leave early just to hurry up and wait. Rules are rules so bear with us. They require we arrive at the door 40 mins prior to our first group heading on tour. So please be prompt Monday morning. Following our visit here, we'll drive 1 mile to Michie's Tavern for a full course all you can eat buffet lunch, including 2 meats and desert! This Tavern, built in 1784 will seat us together beginning at 1:15. We must gather outside and our hostess will escort us in as a group. You will not go away hungry! Following lunch if you want more civil war history, please return to the New Market Battlefield Visitors Center and Museum. (The large building we passed earlier on our way to the VA Civil war museum this am) You are on your own to enjoy downtown New Market or head back toward the hotel and check out other venues of interest.

Silent Auction round one tonight 8:00.

Wednesday 4/29: Today we'll see a local potato chip processing center in operation. Views are from the big plate glass windows. Next we'll enjoy floats. No, we're not talking ice cream but rather parade floats. A box lunch which you pre-ordered will be provided here. Then a very short drive (or hefty walk) to the Shenandoah Caverns. Even if you don't wish to participate and tour the caverns, please go inside the building and visit the gift shop and don't miss the "Main Street of Yesteryear", with its antique store window displays from the 1940's and 1950's. This display is located on the second floor of the caverns building and is free. Spend as much time as you like. If taking the Cavern Tour, it's almost an hour tour.

General Membership Meeting at 7:00 in the hospitality room. Silent auction round two follows at 8:00.

Thursday 4/30: A day of less driving the Valley! Today we'll stay local. A visit to Swannanoa Palace and learn some local history. Then we return to check out downtown Waynesboro. This is a small town with several unique museums. If you so desire, in your books you'll find a map of Staunton, about 10 miles west. There are several museums to visit as well as the Woodrow Wilson Presidential Library/Museum. You are on your own as to how you spend the remainder of the day. There is a huge antique mall located in Verona, about 13 miles and north of Staunton, (an old clothing factory converted to the so called largest antique mall in America, 150,000 sq ft) if you haven't found that just right item at the one in Waynesboro!

We will conclude the day with our farewell banquet with social hour (BYOB) at 5:45 and our bbq at 6:15. Entertainment begins at 7:30. We'll have some business following this before we turn the evening over to enjoying our time together!

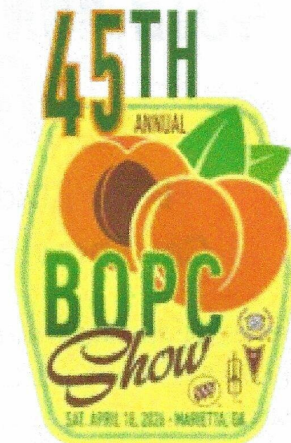

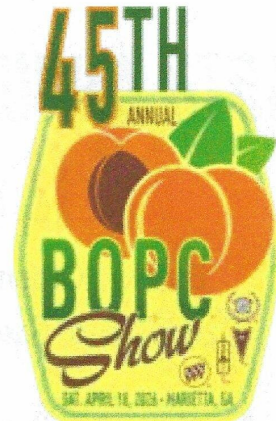

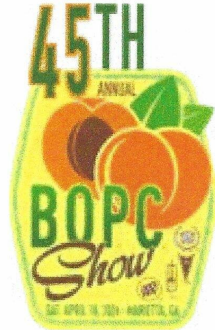
